MATERIALS

DB35055 Cracked Egg Box
C80380 Large Egg
Medium Brush
Detail Brush
Medium Sponge Dabber
Water Based Marker

COLORS

CMM 76 - Lemon Mist

CMM 19 - Banana Boat
CMM 22 - Gecko Green
CMM 55 - Sea Mist
CMM 101 - Fresh Heather
CMM 3 - Carnation
CMM 5 - Coral Reef

CMM 19 - Banana Boat CMM 21 - Mango Madness CMM 57 - Squash Blossom CMM 31 - Licorice



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Paint the outside of the egg box with 3 coats of Carnation.
- 2. Paint the egg with 3 coats of Banana Boat.
- 3. Use the sponge dabber to apply dots on the outside of the egg box. We used Lemon Mist, Coral Reef, Sea Mist, Fresh Heather, and Gecko Green. Apply 2 coats with the sponge end of the dabber.
- 4. Now, dip the stick end of the dabber and add the small dots on the outside of the egg box. Just one coat is enough for these.
- 5. Use a marker to sketch out the details on the egg.
- 6. Use a detail brush to apply 1 heavy coat of Mango Madness to the hair, eyebrows, and wings.
- 7. Dip the stick end of the detail brush into Licorice paint and tap on the eyes.
- 8. Use the small brush to fill in the feet and the beak with 2 heavy coats of Squash Blossom.
- 9. Paint the inside of the egg box with 3 coats of Coral Reef.

TIPS

- Three coats of paint will give you a solid color. You can add water to the paint for a watercolor effect.
- The harder you push down on the detail brush the heavier the lines will be.
- When using a sponge dabber, tap off the excess paint before stamping down.
